They may read right to left or left to right horizontally, vertically, or diagonally. After you have found all the names [some may be found twice—example John] take the remaining unused letters and put them on the blanks below starting from the first row from left to right, followed by those from the second row from left to right, etc. until all the blank below are filled. Note: There are two ASAs. Please circle the letters of the first ASA for Asa Fairfield.
